Opportunity and challenges



Opportunity

- The state possesses many critical elements to achieve it's goals for development and quality of life.
 - A great university system and research facilities
 - World class medical centers
 - Leading high tech companies
 - Major financial center
 - Highly skilled workforce
 - Very attractive state to live and work in



Challenges

- A transportation system that is at capacity and threatens the achievement of the state's goals
- Important transportation assets are not fully utilized but actually threatened
- A number of rail ROW's are not considered assets to help reduce highway congestion or critical to corridor development
- Uncontrolled increases in truck freight threatens the viability of major highways serving high growth regions

Challenges

- Local zoning is at odds with broader regional goals.
- Communities have not embraced transit oriented development
- Industrial property is not viewed as a resource to create new higher paying jobs
- The state's policy (default) is diverting freight from rail to trucks
- Transit investments are reactive not leading



Challenges

Many transportation and industrial assets are not contributing to achieving the state's goals. Therefore they are at risk of permanent loss.



Transit Corridors

- There is a limited no. of transportation corridors (highway, rail, sea and air)
- There may be no more!
- Therefore it is imperative that we develop each to it's optimal utilization
- Many rail and sea corridors are not effectively used and therefore place added demand on highways.

Summary

- Develop and implement a freight plan that is an integral part of our economic and quality of life goals
- Protect and incorporate <u>all</u> rail and industrial assets in plans and development
- Remove all barriers to corridor and transit oriented development
 - Educate and create awareness of the benefits
 - Confront zoning barriers
 - Develop regional partnerships
- Prevent the loss of irreplaceable assets
